GROUP LAUNCHES SANTA CRUZ MOUNTAINS WINEGROWERS EDUCATION FOUNDATION

SILICON VALLEY, CA. (January 16, 2017) – The Santa Cruz Mountains Winegrowers Association (SCMWA) today announced they are expanding their efforts in 2017 to focus on giving back with the launch of the Santa Cruz Mountains Winegrowers Education Foundation (SCMWEF). The Foundation will work with community-based organizations to provide resources and support to benefit educational and research programs in Santa Clara, Santa Cruz and San Mateo counties.

Since 2015, SCMWA and SVEF have partnered to present the Silicon Valley Wine Auction, in support of STEM education. In 2009, the US Department of Labor listed eight STEM careers out of the top ten most highly needed occupations (accounting, computer science, electrical engineering, mechanical engineering, information sciences and systems, computer engineering, civil engineering, and economics and finance) in the near future.

"The Silicon Valley Wine Auction has allowed us to expand programs where additional resources are needed", said Dave House, Board Member of SVEF as well as a member of SCMWA. He added, "We look forward to our long-term partnership with the Santa Cruz Mountains Winegrowers Education Foundation which will help improve education in our community with the primary focus on STEM." Children with a degree in STEM will some-day oversee solving complex problems of today's world and its future. These children will work to find solutions for global warming, cancer, third world hunger, disappearing habitats, and an interdependent world economy.
